# Summer 2006 Tuition & Fee Rates

State Components (Prepaid Prog. Pays)	\$79.90
UF Local Fees (Prepaid Student Pays)	23.22
<b>Florida Rate/Credit Hour</b>	<b>\$103.12</b>
Non-Florida Resident Tuition Fees	470.96
<b>Non-FL Rate/Credit Hour</b>	<b>\$574.08</b>

# Tuition & Fee Payment Deadline

- ◆ 3:30 PM on the second Friday after classes begin
- ◆ You will NOT receive a bill in the mail for tuition
  - Summer B '06: July 14th, 2006
  - Fall '06 : September 1, 2006
  - \$100 Late Payment Fee

# Payment Methods

- ◆ Cashiers at S-113 Criser Hall
  - Cash, checks, debit cards
- ◆ Web ([www.isis.ufl.edu](http://www.isis.ufl.edu)) under Financial Services/Make a Payment
  - MasterCard and American Express-2.6 % service fee will be added
  - Electronic Check (EFT from checking account) This is a FREE service

# Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) for Financial Aid

- ◆ Direct deposit of scholarship and loan proceeds to student's checking account
- ◆ EFT Sign Up on ISIS ([www.isis.ufl.edu](http://www.isis.ufl.edu) under Financial Services)

# Florida Prepaid College Program

- ◆ No need to visit UFS or show UFS student's Prepaid ID card
- ◆ UFS automatically bills Prepaid for \$79.90 per credit hour
- ◆ Student pays \$23.22 per credit hour plus any material & supply fees
- ◆ 2<sup>nd</sup> day after drop/add ends, balance due on ISIS will be adjusted for Prepaid billing
- ◆ Visit UFS if you DON'T want Prepaid billed

*2<sup>nd</sup> function*

## Student Billing

- ◆ UFS acts as billing agent for various UF departments – Libraries, Parking Office, Student Health Care Center (Infirmary)
- ◆ Bills sent the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month to student's local address
- ◆ Bills due the 1<sup>st</sup> of the following month

# Student Billing

- ◆ Financial hold placed on delinquent accounts which prevents receipt of University services
- ◆ Payments are applied to the oldest debt first - tuition & fees or other miscellaneous receivables (library fines, Infirmary charges, parking tickets, etc.)

# Deferments

- ◆ Inform Student Financial Affairs of all outside scholarships
- ◆ Receipt of any financial benefits (scholarships, loans, grants) automatically establishes a tuition & fee deferment
- ◆ Contact Housing about deferment for dorm rent (info with Housing invoice)
- ◆ Contact Bookstore at HUB for book deferment

*3<sup>rd</sup> function*

# Disbursements of Student Financial Benefits

- ◆ Disbursements begin second night of classes (loans); scholarships and grants usually disbursed after drop/add period
- ◆ Debts to UF (tuition, deferred housing) are deducted and paid first. Balance sent to student by check or preferably by EFT direct deposit
- ◆ Disbursement notice to Gatorlink e-mail

# Confidentiality of Student Records

- ◆ Buckley Amendment prevents discussing student's account with anyone without student's permission
- ◆ Student can complete UFS/SFA Information Release form– good at UFS and SFA; need to show UFID
